

GROWING TOGETHER FUND Gay – Straight Alliances Mini-Grants

Mini-grants of up to \$500 are available to Gay – Straight Alliance Clubs in support of their efforts in San Luis Obispo County. Grants are available for projects in three broad categories:

- Advocacy Beyond Campus Projects that reach out to the local community.
 Examples: providing youth speakers for community meetings, participating in Pride in the Plaza, club community service activities.
- Continuity of the Club/Sustainability Projects that work to increase the sustainability of Gay – Straight Alliances Clubs. Examples: increasing membership, outreach to allies, training for existing members, club presence at school wide activities such as homecoming, club buttons, stickers and t-shirts to increase awareness of club.
- Community Education On-campus projects that reach out to club member's fellow students. Examples: sponsoring activities such as guest speakers, film screenings, "Coming Out Day" or "Day of Silence".

Eligibility:

- a) Applicant is a new, re-emerging, or existing Gay Straight Alliances Club; and
- b) Club is based at a San Luis Obispo County high school or at Cuesta College; and
- c) Planned activities are consistent with school district parameters.

Funding:

Accepted grant applications will receive funding for projects to take place during the current academic year. Requests for funding in the following academic year will be considered on a case by case basis.

Deadline for Application: Completed and signed applications may be submitted for consideration at any time at 550 Dana Street, San Luis Obispo, CA. Faxed applications will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Allow up to 45 days for grant award decision to be made.
