

- b) Demonstration of satisfactory academic achievement (2.0 or greater); and,
- c) Demonstration of school and community involvement.







Some applications will ask you **prequalifying questions** to determine your eligibility for the scholarship. If you are eligible, you will be directed to the application.





- Applications can be printed at any time as a reference tool.
- If you do not complete all portions of the application, you can save your progress and return to it at any time before the deadline.

Application Sections (1-5):

- ✓ Section 1: Personal Information
 - Name, Date of Birth, Address, Contact Information
- ✓ Section 2: Academic Information

 Test Scores (optional), College Choices, Major/ Proposed Career
- ✓ Section 3: Activities
 - You **MUST** use the fillable Activities form we provide (Google Doc or PDF) to complete and upload to your application.
- ✓ Section 4: Personal Essay(s)
 - Pick one of the essay prompts. You can type it directly into the application or upload a file.
- ✓ Section 5: Extraordinary Family Obligation/ Student Challenges

Application Sections (6-9):

✓ Section 6: Letter of Recommendation

Suggestion: Complete this section <u>first!</u> Your application is **NOT** complete until your recommendation is submitted. Once you complete this section, an email will be delivered to the recommender. Your application isn't complete until they submit their letter to the link they receive.

- ✓ Section 7: Financial Statement
 FAFSA/ CADAA, Student Aid Report, Expected Family Contribution
- ✓ Section 8: Supplemental Essays

A few scholarships will refer to a supplemental essay. It will be referenced in the Personal Essay section.

✓ Section 9: Certify and Submit Application

- Applications may require a supplemental essay
