Suggested Language for Charitable Bequests and Distributions

The sample bequest language is offered for your legal counsel's consideration in preparing your will or trust. **C**onsult your attorney on the appropriate wording to reflect your own goals and intentions. Please be sure the Foundation's correct legal name appears in all final documents as: "The Community Foundation San Luis Obispo County, a California nonprofit corporation, or its successor."

Outright Bequest or Distribution

Contingent Bequest or Contribution
