



Gender Sexuality Alliance (GSA) Club Grant Application

The Community Foundation's Growing Together: An LGBTQ+ Fund distributes grants to local organizations that focus on creating an inclusive environment.

Grants of up to \$500 are available to Gender Sexuality Alliance (GSA) Clubs in support of their efforts in San Luis Obispo and Northern Santa Barbara County. Grants are available for projects in three categories:

- **Advocacy On-Campus** – Projects that reach out to club member's fellow students. Examples: activities, guest speakers, film screenings, and club swag to increase awareness such as buttons, stickers, and t-shirts.
- **Advocacy Off-Campus** – Projects that reach out to the local community. Examples: providing youth speakers for community meetings, participating in Central Coast Pride, and club community service activities.
- **Club Support and Enrichment** – Support for club activities and operations. Examples: fieldtrips, training for existing club members, club presence at school wide activities, food/supplies for club meetings and activities.

Eligibility:

- a) Applicant is a school approved Gender Sexuality Alliance Club; and
- b) Club is based at a San Luis Obispo County or Northern Santa Barbara County high school or middle school, or at Cuesta College or Allan Hancock College; and
- c) Planned activities are consistent with school district parameters.

Funding:

Accepted grant applications will receive funding for projects to take place during the current academic year. Requests for funding in the following academic year will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Funding cannot be used for activities and purchases that have already occurred.

Submission and Deadline:

Applications and may be submitted for consideration at any time during the school year. Submit completed application and budget to The Community Foundation San Luis Obispo County, via email to info@cfsloco.org. Allow up to 45 days for grant award decisions. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
