





ROLE OF THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION

A grantmaking and education foundation supporting charitable work across our county.

Established in 1998, has awarded over 70 million since it's inception to over 2,500 organizations and over 1,500 students.



DONOR ADVISED FUNDS

Charitable funds started by individuals in their lifetimes

Tax deduction the year the gift was made

Do not have to make the final decision at the time of the gift

# WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Programs benefiting San Luis Obispo County residents

Tax Exempt 501(c)(3)

Current memorandum of understanding outlining fiscal sponsorship with 501 (c)(3)

# WHO IS NOT ELIGIBLE?

#### Individuals

Organizations that discriminate based on: age, disability, ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, race or religion

Fraternal Organizations

Governmental Organizations

Indirect Administrative costs greater than 15% of the awarded funds

Fundraising events

Organizations with religious affiliations

Organizations and programs designed to elect candidates to public office

Organizations located outside SLO County Unless the program benefits residents of-and conducted within-SLO County

Pay off past debts or existing obligations

**Endowment funds** 

Scholarships, fellowships, travel grants and technical or specialized research

# OVERVIEW OF WOMEN'S LEGACY FUND

Endowment Fund created by the Community Foundation in 2003

Mission: to be a catalyst for philanthropy that improves the lives of women and girls

Only fund in SLO County targeted to support women and girls alone

Guided by advisory committee Supported by over 1600 donors


Fund has awarded over \$672,000

# 2024 WOMEN'S LEGACY FUND PRIORITIES

- Girls Mental Health
- Examples: Self-care, chronic sadness, addressing bullying and harassment, internet safety
- Women's Financial Stability
- Examples: Financial literacy & education, economic independence, support for Latinas, income disparity, food security, senior support, housing stability
- Childcare
- Examples: access to childcare for low-income families, expanded capacity for childcare, improvement of childcare facilities, professional development for pre-k and preschool educators
- Maximum grant amount will be \$20,000 per year for a total of \$40,000 for two-year proposals.
- Have approximately \$75,000 to award total in 2024









JANSSEN YOUTH & YOUTH SPORTS

Support programs that enrich the lives of local youth and ideally reflect the Search Institute's 40 Developmental Assets.

Preference given to youth sports programs and direct services costs.

Emphasis on active participation over educational programming, provide access to all segments of the community regardless of income level.

Maximum Grant Size: \$10,000

Average anticipated grant size of \$5,000 with \$50,000 available in 2024

### NARRATIVE: WHAT MAKES A GOOD PROJECT

DATA INFORMED

THE GRANT IS A GOOD MATCH

THE APPLICANT HAS CREDIBILITY

GOOD PLANNING IS EVIDENT

THE HIGHEST LEVELS OF GOVERNANCE IN THE ORGANIZATION HAVE A HIGH COMMITMENT TO THE PROJECT

#### Fit

Strong fit with your organization's mission and priorities

#### **Priorities**

Meets one or more of the funding priorities, data supported

#### **Objectives**

Clear statement of project / program objectives

#### **Activities**

The planned activities and timeline are practical to meet projected outcomes

#### **Success**

Demonstrates likelihood of success. Best practices, community input, collaboration

#### **Budget**

Proposed budget is complete and realistic
